Falling vehicle

Squashing or crushing

Damage to the vehicle

- · Avoid placing solid objects under the raised vehicle.
- Ensure that the lifting platform is prevented from lowering.
- · Remove solid objects before lowering the vehicle.
- · Lift the vehicle only at the jacking points provided.
- The outer jacking points should primarily be used.




Incorrect handling of safety bolts

Injuries

Loss of torque

- Always use new fastening screws and nuts following removal.
- · Observe specified tightening torques.
- · Carry out a visual inspection of all parts used.





Working with compressed air

Eye injuries

Damage and dirtying of components

- · Wear protective goggles with side eye protection.
- Protect the point where the compressed air emerges with suitable material.
- Place the point where the compressed air emerges on a suitable surface.





Toxic exhaust gases

Danger of suffocation

 With the engine running, position the exhaust gas removal system behind the vehicle's exhaust pipes and switch it on.



Danger of objects or loads falling down

Squashing or crushing

• Secure components to prevent them from falling down.



Airborne foreign bodies during grinding,

drilling and milling

Risk of eye injuries

· Wear protective goggles.



Non-heat resistant materials

Fire

 Avoid contact with hot components or sources of ignition.



Caution

Pointed or sharp objects

Cracks, pricks or cuts

· Wear personal protective equipment.



Caution

Hot components

Risk of burns

- · Let hot components cool down.
- ·Wear personal protective equipment.




Heavy components


Risk of squashing

- Get someone to help if necessary.





Step 1:


Remove the paneling beneath the steering wheel according to the Porsche specifications.


Pay attention to pipes that are mounted to the paneling. The pipes of the fire extinguishing system have to be loosened at the T-piece. The other pipes can be dismounted by opening the cable ties.



Step 2:


- Mark the holes, that have to be drilled for the rivets using the included holder.
 - Cut the central hole using an air saw into the paneling.
- Drill the Ø 3mm holes at the previously marked positions.
- Rivet the holder on the paneling.
- For more stability use flat washers behind the rivets.
- Drill the three Ø 7mm holes into the paneling.







Step 3:

Mount the 3 rivet nuts to the holder.

Step 4:

Bolt the brake balance adjuster to the holder.

The hole in the red balance controller should point downwards.

The included nuts, which belong to the 3 screws of the brake adjuster, are not going to be used and remain after the assembly.

Step 5:

Push the sealing towards the trunk.

Step 6:

- Drill a Ø 10mm hole into the sealing.
- Put the grommet into the hole
- Reassemble the sealing.





Step 7:

If the potentiometer is not being used, attach it behind the paneling using a cable tie.

Step 8:

Loosen the grub screw of the clutch.


Step 9: (optional)

Dismount the compensating reservoir FA from its holder by cutting the cable tie.


Step 10:

- Loosen the securing of the balance bar on both sides by pulling out the safety pin.
- The shown securing will not be needed anymore.





Step 11:

The securing on the left in driving direction is mounted to the right side.

Step 12:

Adjust the balance bar according to the specifications.

Step 13:

Twist the cable tie holder.

In this part of the process you have to work from inside of the footwell.

Stick the cable tie holder to the shown position.


Place the shaft as it is shown in the picture.


The shaft is must not interfere with the steering mechanic in any circumstances!

Step 14:


Reassemble the paneling beneath the steering wheel according to the Porsche specifications.

Pass the shaft through the drilled sealing, connect the clutch with the balance bar and fasten the grub screw to the clutch.
